In PE class, each student was asked to run the 50 yard dash. Scott completed it in 14.6 seconds while Andrew completed it in 13.7 seconds. How much faster did Andrew run the 50 yard dash?

Jessica went to the mall to buy a new dress. The dress cost \$59.99 and she had a \$5.00 off coupon to use. How much was the dress after the coupon was applied?

Andy, Bill and Peter bought some candy on their way home from school. They bought a candy bar for \$0.80, a lollipop for \$0.30 and a pack of gum for \$1.10. How much did they spend in all?

Lauren decided to pay some bills she got in the mail. Her water bill was \$37.65, her cable bill was \$107.63 and her gas bill was \$79.86. What was the total of all of her bills?

Roger was going camping and needed to buy some gear. His tent cost \$22.65, his sleeping bag cost \$9.86 and his flashlight cost \$5.33. How much did Roger spend on camping gear?

School was starting and Anthony needed some school supplies. He bought two packs of pencils for \$1.50 each, three rubber erasers for \$0.75 each and a packet of lined paper for \$2.00. What was the total for Anthony's school supplies?

New York got 14.5 inches of snow in December and 20.6 inches of snow in January. How much more snow did New York get in January?

Matthew and Alicia wanted to know who could unpack their schoolbag faster. Matthew did it in 63.4 seconds and Alicia did it in 58.3 seconds. Who won? By how much?

Carol was measuring the height of three of her friends. The first was 53.4 inches tall. The second was 56.3 inches tall. Her third friend was 59.8 inches tall. What was the height difference between her tallest and shortest friend?

Bill was traveling for vacation. He drove 368.4 miles the first day and 480.9 miles the second day. How many miles did Bill travel?

Jane and Abigail measured the lengths of their bedrooms. Jane's was 11.75 feet and Abigail's was 14.5 feet. How much longer was Abigail's room?

Henry had \$200 when he went to the mall to buy some gifts. The first purchase was for \$132.54 and the second purchase was for \$36.98. How much money did he come home with?

Jack wanted to measure the perimeter of the triangular sandbox. One side was 4.5 feet. The second side was 6.4 feet. The third side was 4.6 feet. What was the perimeter of the sandbox?

After buying some food from the vending machine, Tom has \$0.15 left. If he bought \$3.75 worth of food, how much money did Tom have before he spent it on food?

Gloria and Maddie went to a concert. The tickets cost \$20.50 each and they both bought tshirts for \$18.75 each. How much did they spend altogether for the concert?

Carol wanted to weigh both of her cats to see which one weighed more. Her gray cat weighed 15.82 pounds and her white cat weighed 13.22 pounds. How much more did her gray cat weigh?
